It engages students in practical experiences with an emphasis on getting them out of the classroom and into real-life situations.

The Inspiration Programme is a 1 year programme which achieves the crucial Gatsby Benchmarks, with students following a different pillar each half-term.

The Breakout Programme is a hard-hitting 12-week, anti-knife and gang programme, designed to bring positive change to the lives of young people at risk of being sucked into crime and of losing purpose in their lives.

Developed to have maximum impact The Breakout Programme is tailored to individual needs and uses a package of mentoring, classroom and outdoor education sessions. We work with schools to identify participants, typically those displaying various early indicators of susceptibility to crime e.g. risk of exclusion from school, disruptive behaviour, poor school attendance, anti-social behaviour and possibly already having had some negative contact with the police. Some schools also like to target pupils for very early intervention with the aim of reducing certain behaviour patterns occurring.

The targeted intervention runs for 0.5 day each week over a 12-week period for groups of 10 young people. Schools know their pupils well and can easily highlight which students identify at risk.
